I have run autotune a bunch of times, but it keeps getting farther and farther off. So I am interested in tuning from scratch, unless there is an unpublished bin that is close to my setup. My setup is

TE44
1.6 rockers
MSD
3 bar
50# injectors
UR6
water to air (with extra heat exchanger and bigger pump)
stock heads,cam and converter
